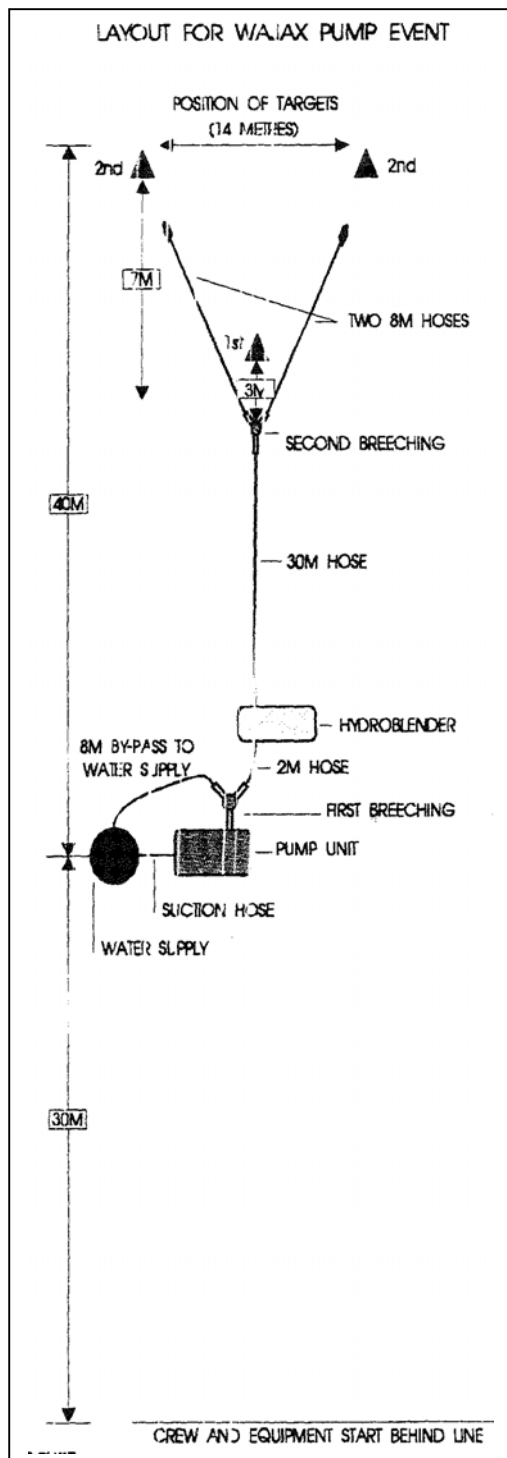


REPLACEMENT LENGTH EVENT



General Competition Rules apply.

1. EQUIPMENT

As for Standard Wajax Event.

2. OPEN EVENT DRILL

Complete Standard Wajax run until both 2nd targets have been tipped or broken.

Note: these targets will then be reset.

No's 1 and 2 signal water off to No 3.

No 3 signals water off to pump operator.

No 1 returns to hydroblender with hose pack, and lays 2nd 30m length from pack to 2nd breaching.

No 2 returns to hydroblender, disconnects 30m length and ties a knot with the female end of the hose. Attaches and secures 2nd 30 m length to hydroblender, then returns to target area. No's 1 and 3 attach and secure 2nd 30m length to 2nd breaching.

No's 1 and 2 signal water on and operate branches to tip the 2nd targets.

No 3 acknowledges signals, signals water on to pump operator, and operates 2nd breaching.

The drill is complete when both targets have been tipped or broken.

Note: No 4 cannot assist No's 1 and 2 in replacing the 30m length. After completion of drill, all equipment is to be left for judges to inspect.

3. ADDITIONAL PENALTIES

Standard Wajax Event penalties apply. In addition, a 5 second penalty will be added for failure to securely knot the replaced 30m length.

4. LADIES EVENT DRILL

Same as for the open event.
